

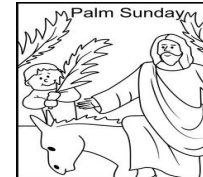

The decision was taken by the Diocese in consultation with Joe Walsh Tours in the light of the Covid 19 Coronavirus Pandemic which prevents us guaranteeing the health and safety of all who travel with us.

The agreement is with JWT to carry forward to next year all current bookings so that there will be no financial loss to those who are booked. Please do not at this time contact JWT as staff are working from home and do not have full access to their office. A decision on the Autumn Pilgrimage will be taken in due course.

**Clarecare Parent Support:** Family life has become somewhat more complicated now that we have to respond to Covid-19. We very much appreciate the new challenges presented to parents and families at this time. How we work with families has changed temporarily due to the current restrictions in place so unfortunately we are not in a position to deliver the spring/summer group parenting programmes as planned.
