## Sixmilebridge Historical Society - Heritage Event

The Sixmilebridge Historical Society will have a walking tour of the town, starting at the square, formerly known as Hanover Square at 7pm, on Thursday August 18<sup>th</sup>. The tour will be led by Michael Mc Namara and will concentrate informing the participants about the origins of the historic names of streets and squares, and the significance of specific buildings. The society has been engaged in erecting plaques on buildings with a specific heritage value in the town during the last two years and many of these buildings will be visited, creating a new awareness of the historic characteristics of Sixmilebridge town. The event will finish by 9.00 pm, all are welcome and the event is free.

They have a fantastic team of volunteers who deliver the meals across 6 routes from Mon to Fri between 11am and 1.30pm. They have 6 branded Meals on Wheels vehicles and each delivery route takes no more than 2 hours per day. Obair deliver to Ennis, Shannon, Sixmilebridge, Kilmurry, Clarecastle, Quin, Doorabarefield, Newmarket on Fergus, Kilkishen and Cratloe

### **The role involves:**

Driving or accompanying a driver to and from delivery locations and returning to Newmarket on Fergus after each route, carrying the individually packaged meals from the van to the door of each household, spending a few minutes chatting with the service users on a route.
