Confirmation Dates - Rescheduled 2021

Confirmation will go ahead on the dates given last week. All the necessary precautions will be taken in the Church, but we are strongly recommending that all the same precautions will be taken by the families on returning home.

Sixmilebridge: Monday 16th August,
Tuesday 17th and Thursday 19th August all at 7.00 p.m.
Kilmurry: Wednesday 18th August at 7.00 p.m.

We are taking into consideration that some families may be away on holiday. If this is the case please just contact the Parish Office and we will accommodate you at a later date.

We will continue to observe extreme caution in complying with all Health and Safety Guidelines. However, if any parent/family feel nervous to attend due to COVID please just let us know and you will be accommodated later when restrictions are eased.

As we outlined in our previous correspondence each candidate will be accompanied by **two adults** only, one which will be the Sponsor. Once assigned your seat on arrival, we ask you to please remain there until you are directed by a steward.

Please remain seated throughout the ceremony. Please use hand sanitisers provided at the Church doors when entering and exiting the Church.

I will administer the Sacrament of Confirmation. You will be directed from your seat.

We ask all adults to please wear a **Face Covering** when entering the Church.

Toilets will **not** be in use only in case of emergency. Please do not leave any items on seats when you leave. We would like this to be both a spiritual and happy occasion for everyone.

We ask people to follow the same guidelines for all Masses.

Please bear with us while we do everything we can to keep people safe during this pandemic.
