Important Public Health Advice

Following advice from the HSE and Nphet to Bishops during the week, all Parishes have been asked to postpone the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation until further notice.

This is due to the high volume of the highly transmissible Delta variant of COVID-19 circulating in the Mid West Area.

We regret any inconvenience and disappointment this may cause, but we have decided in the interest of Public Health and Safety to adhere to these instructions.

In relation to Baptisms we have been advised only to hold these where it is deemed pastorally necessary and with only Parents, God Parents and Grandparents in attendance.

Our Churches are safe places to worship and stewards are in place at all Masses to ensure all safety measures are adhered to.

We ask everyone to wear a face mask and use hand sanitiser when entering and leaving the Church. We ask you to please do not leave any newsletters, tissues etc., on the seat when you leave.

If you feel unwell in any way please do not feel that you have to come to Mass.

Webcam will be on in Sixmilebridge Church at all Masses.

This week we have been told that 5000 people have sadly died in this country since the pandemic began, due to this deadly virus.

We keep their families in our prayers.

We need to trust the advice given to us by our Medical People and our Government and thank them for guiding us through this difficult time.
